Ed Watts, Trustee from Canajoharie spoke about the Brownfield grant that is due next month, waterfront revitalization grant. He also discussed an Industrial Park for the western end of the County consisting of shipping and rail that is due at the end of July.

There was discussion about the repairs to the roof on the Community House that are needed. Nino Polidori asked why the repairs weren't done sooner, and how it would be paid for. Trustee Elwood suggested that it be researched more. Since the building is historical, a historical architect is needed to have the front porch repaired, and the deadline has passed for any grant.

Discussion was had about new software for the office such as what upgrades are needed there was no information about the cost.

The office will look for the resolution as to what was the intentional use for the Community House Reserve and Repairs.

There was more discussion about how the Brownfield Opportunity Area grant works. You apply, and if approved there is a 10% fee to be paid. The upper mill which is one of the properties that need Level 2 work done before anything further can be done.
